Barcelona-Shanghai Bridge

2021 marks the **20th anniversary** of the signing of the **Shanghai-Barcelona Sister-City Agreement**. City relations were initiated by the former Mayor of Barcelona, Mr Pasqual Maragall and the then Mayor of Shanghai, Mr Zhu Rongji, with the signing of a Memorandum in 1988. In 2001 the former Mayor of Barcelona, Mr Joan Clos and the Vice Mayor of Shanghai Municipal Government, Mr Zhou Muyao, officially signed the twinning agreement.

The cities' commitment to this long-standing friendship has inspired Barcelona City Council to organise **the BARCELONA-SHANGHAI BRIDGE to commemorate this special occasion in collaboration** with the Foreign Affairs Office of the Shanghai Municipal People's Government.

Two cities with common goals

Where East meets West, **Shanghai and Barcelona** are cities that **share common goals**. Both cities are **economic engines** in their territories and beyond, **open to international trade and commercial exchange**.

Both cities have a **long history of culture and traditions** and are proud of their **strong identities** and recognised **global city-branding.** Both are well-known internationally and renowned for being centres for creativity, design, and talent attraction, among other strengths.

Barcelona and Shanghai **value innovation and entrepreneurship.** Both cities are global references with **excellent business ecosystems for landing international start-ups and scale-ups** in their markets.



When and how

The timeframe of the **BARCELONA-SHANGHAI BRIDGE** STARTS during "**Smart City Expo Shanghai**" (14 October), spanning over the China International Import Expo (CIIE) (5-10 Nov). It CLOSES with the **"Smart Cities World Congress EXPO Barcelona**" (18 November).

The BRIDGE will host a **series of planned events and activities** carried out by different **public and private stakeholders** from Barcelona-Catalonia and their Shanghai-China counterparts. The activities will cover different areas such as city diplomacy, culture, economy, education, innovation and tourism. The majority of these events will be online, but some will be held offline.

The **BARCELONA-SHANGHAI BRIDGE** is coordinated by the Departments of **International Relations and City Promotion** of **Barcelona City Council** with the support of the **Foreign Affairs Office of Shanghai Municipal People's Government.**

On 14 October, at 9 am, the Shanghai Post Office will issue a collectable set of 5,000 stamps, matching postcards and envelopes celebrating the Barcelona-Shanghai Bridge. 
